Subject Arrested for Vandalism of Local Fire Dept. Parking Lot

Fleetwood, N.C. – Sheriff B. Phil Howell announces the arrest of 20-year-old Daniel Ryan Goodman of Fleetwood after the local fire department wanted to report property damage.



On July 10th, 2023, Fleetwood Fire Department reported that their parking lot had been damaged to the Ashe County Sheriff's Office. A vehicle had left several hundred feet of black marks throughout the parking lot, covering the parking lines. The fire department has had a recent history of parking lot damage in the past few years, resulting in several thousands of dollars. After an investigation by Detective Hicks, the responsible subject was found to be Daniel Goodman. Damage to the Fleetwood Fire Department was estimated at \$1,000.

After an arrest warrant was issued, Deputy Wingler located Goodman, who was placed under arrest without incident. Goodman was transported to the Ashe County Sheriff's Office, placed under a \$4,000 secured bond, and later released.
